## **Approval of minutes**

Luke Adams motioned to approve minutes for March 11, 2022 meeting, seconded by Thomas Walsman. Motion passed unanimously.

#### **Current accounting report**

Due to ESSR money covering some of the previously budgeted expenses, the Trustlands budget was set to exceed the amount allowed to carryover. The council approved a purchase of student laptops for \$12,500 out of this year's budget.

## Review proposed 2022-2023 TSSP

The council voted on the following goals and budget which passed unanimously.

Expected carryover from 21-22: \$28,757.45 Estimated distribution for 22-23: \$138,771

Total estimated 22-23 Trustlands budget: \$167,528.45

Goal #1: Ten percent of the North Layton Student Body will increase their communication skills through an improvement in individual writing abilities; to be determined by the school wide use of an established and normed rubric. \$9,400 for Teacher completion and incentives

Goal #2: Increase the number of students on track for graduation by five percent. On-Track students will have a minimum of six credits and all their core credits when they complete their 9th grade year. Instructional Coaches \$36,000, Full-time Employee Position \$100,000, Technology including Monitors and Display Adaptors \$6,615, Dream Box Licenses \$5,500

Goal #3: The North Layton Junior High student body will have 70% of all students either maintain an equivalent grade level score or achieve an increase of 50 points on the scale over the 2021 - 2022 school year on the Reading Inventory scale.

Total 22-23 Estimated expenditures: \$157,515

Estimated carryover to 23-24: \$10,013.45
