STEP 1 - LET'S CHECK YOUR GRADES & ATTENDANCE

- You are earning HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS
- Pass all classes / Attend school
 - Attendance is huge predictor of success or failure
 - Credit Recovery is much harder than a classroom
- Make up lost credits as quickly as possible





WHAT IS GOOD ATTENDANCE?

- If you miss two days a month, you are considered
 Chronically Absent
- EVERY
 DAY
 MATTERS
 SCHOOL+YOU=SUCCESS
- Research shows that attendance in elementary and junior high is a BIG PREDICTOR of finishing high school
 - More kids with low attendance drop-out of high school
 - We want every Longhorn to graduate one day!
- Practice going to school every day so you can do it in college or at a job one day



IS IT TOO EARLY TO THINK ABOUT SCHOLARSHIPS?






- Get involved in school
